Minor Operations

In addition to standard Medical Centre services, we also offer a range of minor operations including diathermy, cryotherapy, suture of lacerations and skin cancer removal surgery. All our surgical instruments are sterilized according to standards.

Appointments with your Doctor

The preferred booking method is online however if you are a new patient, require the nurse or a long appointment, please ring (02) 4862 7666. Every effort will be made to accommodate your preferred time and GP. Appointments are usually made at 15-minute intervals. Longer consultations are available, please inform the receptionists if you require extra time. Emergencies will always be given priority and our reception staff will attempt to contact you if there is any unforeseen delay or your GP has been called away. If you or a family member requires an interpreter, we can organise this for you. Please let us know when you make an appointment.

Fees and billing arrangements

Universal bulk-billing is not financially viable and would mean this practice could not provide quality service. However, we may use bulk-billing and concession fees to aid the disadvantage, multiple family consultations or prolonged treatment programs and children under 16 years. Procedures may incur higher or different fees.

Most specialist consultations are privately billed, please check with reception staff when you make your appointment. We accept cash, eftpos, and MasterCard / Visa credit cards.

There are some consultations that cannot be bulk billed and these include such things as:

- Workers Compensation
- Pre-Employment Medical Examinations
- Insurance Medicals
- Providing services to people not covered by Medicare /Veterans Affairs
- Some specialist's consultations

The standard consultation fee is \$98.00 (8.00am - 5.00pm weekdays) and \$110.00 - \$200.00 on weekends and out of hours (all other times).

Treatment Room Fee's Private Patients

Due to increasing consumable costs and the Government freeze on Medicare we are no longer able to absorb the ongoing costs for Wound Care Products. Minimum fee is \$5.00 and a maximum of \$50.00 dependent on wound care required. Please feel free to ask the nurse if you need further information.

After Hours

Home Visits

Home visits are available for regular patients whose condition prevents them from attending the Medical Centre. Please discuss fees and billing arrangements with your doctor.

Telephone Access

Doctors in the Medical Centre may be contacted during normal operating hours for urgent healthcare needs. If the doctor is with a patient, the reception staff will take a detailed message and forward this onto the doctor as soon as possible. In an emergency, your call will always be put through to either the doctor or nurse.

Parking and Disabled Access

Ample car parking is available with separate parking bays allocated to our disabled patients.

Your Feedback, Quality and Improvement

We have a feedback form and box located on the reception desk for patients to provide feedback. We take your feedback very seriously and will try to improve on any recommendations made from our patients.

Reminder System

Our practice is committed to preventative care. Your doctor will seek your permission to be included on our reminder system. We may issue you with a reminder notice from time to time offering you preventive health services appropriate to your care. If you do not wish to be part of this system, please let your doctor or reception know.

Results

If your doctor has requested any tests such as X-Rays or Pathology the doctor will read the report and then if he/she requires you to return to discuss these results the nurse will contact you and ask you to come in for another appointment. Results will not be given over the phone so please make an appointment if you wish to discuss your results with the doctor.

Medical Records and Privacy

Your medical record is a confidential document. It is the policy of this practice to maintain security of personal health information at all times and ensure this information is only available to authorised members of staff.

Eastbrooke Medical Centre Southern Highlands complies with the Privacy Act 1988 and the Australian Privacy Principles 2014 including the way we collect, store, use and disclose health information.
